

In-person Visits

- Visiting will begin Saturday and Sunday. B-Unit and 512 will begin Sunday, April 18, 2021.
- All visits must be scheduled through ICSolutions at www.icsolutions.com
- All visits must be scheduled at least 72 hours in advance and are limited to immediate family or primary visitor only.
- If visitor has not scheduled through the ICS system, they will be refused entry in the facility.
No special visits.
- All visits are scheduled in one (1) hour blocks.

- All visitors will be required to wear a mask. Children over the age of two must also wear masks. Masks must be kept on at all times and cover the mouth and nose. Visitors must provide their own masks.
- Each visitor will be required to have their temperature taken along with being asked a series of questions regarding symptoms or contact with anyone within the last 14 days suspected of having the virus. If symptomatic, access to the facility will be denied.
- No food or vending machines will be allowed at this time.
- Residents are limited to two (2) visitors. One of the two visitors may be a child.
- No physical contact is allowed.
- If your visitor arrives late the visit will end at the scheduled time. If the resident arrives late to the visit, the visit will still end at the scheduled time.
