Religious Services and Groups

Residents shall be permitted to practice a religion to which they sincerely ascribe within the limitations imposed by individual facility physical structures, staffing levels, other considerations of security, good order and discipline, consistent with consideration of costs and limited resources. All limitations or prohibitions shall be consistent with considerations of whether the limitation or prohibition is in furtherance of a compelling government interest and is the least restrictive means of furthering that compelling governmental interest. <u>IMPP 10-110D</u> (link to <u>https://powerdms.com/docs/2340869</u>)
